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Higher Education Restructuring

To provide public colleges and universities with more operational and administrative autonomy in exchange for a renewed commitment to their public missions.



Institutional Concerns

- Lack of predictability in funding, inability to plan
- Inability to use “market strength” to meet institutional goals
- Perception of undue administrative burdens
- ‘Charter’ institutions proposal




2005 Restructuring Act

- Operational autonomy for all institutions
- T&F responsibility of BOV
- Commitment to “state ask”
- Performance measures and financial incentives
- Opportunity for greater institutional autonomy, including “management agreement”



In-State Enrollment has grown


In-State Enrollment





Degrees have increased


Degree Awards





Some Degrees have not grown


High-Need Degrees - Four-Year Institutions





Retention improved, but...


Average Retention Rate





Transfers have increased


Two-Year Transfers





Dual Enrollments are up



Research Expenditures (In Millions)


