The James Monroe office tower building houses a number of state agencies, including SCHEV. The building address is 101 N. 14th St. If traveling from...

I-95 NORTHBOUND:

Take exit 74A to merge onto I-195 North/Downtown Expressway. (Portions are toll.) Take the Canal Street exit toward US-60. Turn right onto 10th Street. Take a right onto Cary Street. Turn left onto 14th Street. The James Monroe Building is the 25-story building on your left. On-street parking may be available. Otherwise, public parking is located on Cary Street.

I-95 SOUTHBOUND:

Take 74B – Franklin Street Exit. Turn right at the light. The James Monroe Building is the 25-story building on your right. On-street parking may be available in front of the Monroe Building. Otherwise, take a left on 14th Street. Then take a left on Cary Street. Public parking is located on your left a block down Cary Street.

I-64 EAST- AND WESTBOUND:

Take I-64 to I-95 South. Take Franklin Street Exit (the first exit after I-64 and I-95 split). Turn right at the light. The James Monroe Building is the 25-story building on your right. On-street parking may be available. Otherwise, take a left on 14th Street. Then take a left on Cary Street. Public parking is located on your left a block down Cary Street.

Parking

Please be aware all parking spaces in close proximity to the James Monroe Building have a fee. Options are listed below, please plan accordingly:

- Metered 2-hour parking is available on 14th and Franklin Streets - \$2.50 per 2 hours (cash and debt and credit cards accepted)
- Flat lot and deck parking is located on the corners of Main and 14th and 15th St. for \$5 – 2 hours, \$8 – 4 hours, and \$12 – 10 hours. (cash, debt and credit cards accepted)

Please note that these parking options require an *uphill* walk to the building entrance. Please contact me before the meeting date, if you need assistance.

Access to the James Monroe Building

Access to the state government building **requires identification** and no fire arms are allowed.

- Please enter at the 14th Street entrance, below the pedestrian bridge
- Take the elevator to bridge (1) level and enter the glass doors to your right
- Stop at the security desk on your right. You will be asked to sign- in, provide photo ID and for the purpose of your visit and its location:
 - Student Advisory Committee Meeting, Conference Room B. ([804-225-2600](tel:804-225-2600))
 - You must show a **picture ID** to receive a visitor name tag
 - All visitors must be escorted in, out, and around the building
 - You may have to wait briefly for SCHEV staff to meet and escort you to Conference Room B (located next to the security desk)
