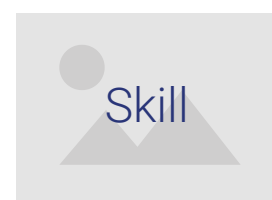

Instructions for Downloading your Military Transcript.

If you serve or have served in the Army, Marine Corps, Navy or Coast Guard:
 --Download and save your JST (Joint Services Transcript)(link is external), using either the Transcript or Combo Report format from the set of options available on the JST page, to your computer.
 --Then use the Browse/Choose File... button above to select the JST that you downloaded.
 --Click on Upload to have C2C analyze your JST and add to My Story.

If you are serving in the Air Force:
 --Log into the AF Portal and further to AFVEC (Air Force Virtual Education Center). Under Self Service click "CCAF View Progress Report(link is external)" and save the PDF to your computer.
 --Then use the Browse/Choose File... button to select the Web Progress Report that you saved to your computer.
 --Click on Upload to have C2C analyze your Web Progress Report and add to My Service.

Please note that:
 --You must upload the PDF you download from the JST or Air Force Portal site. C2C cannot process a PDF generated from scanning a paper copy of the transcript.
 --C2C only evaluates JSTs or CCAF Web Progress Reports uploaded on this transcript page. It will not read and evaluate other college or university transcripts, certificates or other documents that you upload. If you have other transcripts or documents that you would like transfer estimates on, please use the Add to My Service page to add courses, licenses and training to view estimated transfer credit. If you have questions or need assistance, please use the My Advisor function in the menu above to request an advisor to be assigned to you. Once assigned, contact your assigned Advisor to review and evaluate other documentation that you may have.
 --Should you decide to apply to VCCS, JSTs, CCAF Transcripts, and any other documentation you upload or enter into C2C, is not transferred to your official student record, . You will be required to send in official copies of all transcripts and documentation for official evaluation at the time of application.
