

General Studies Associate Degrees Recognized by the State Policy on College Transfer

(Updated October 13, 2021)

The State Policy on College Transfer indicates that recipients of transfer degrees, admitted through a regular admission process, are to be afforded junior standing and satisfaction of lower-level general education requirement (see the Policy for details and caveats).

In addition to the transfer degrees identified in the State Policy on College Transfer, recipients of recognized General Studies associate degrees offered by Virginia Community Colleges may also utilize the State Policy on College Transfer.
