






#### 2023 Student Shed for Virginia's Four-Year Public Colleges and Universities






#### 2023 Student Shed for CICV's Private Non-Profit Colleges and Universities








Percentage of In-State Fall Undergraduates Who Received PELL Grants in Fall 2022


#### **Average Headcount Enrollment in Fall 2023**


#### **Average Student to Faculty Ratio in Fall 2022**


