

#### SCHEV's Strategic Plan Duty

- The *Code of Virginia* charges SCHEV with the responsibility to develop a statewide strategic plan that:
  - Reflects statutory goals for higher education in the Commonwealth,
  - Identifies a coordinated approach to such state and regional goals, and
  - Emphasizes the future needs for higher education in Virginia.
- Approved in January 2021, Pathways to Opportunity: The Virginia Plan for Higher Education identifies trends that the Commonwealth must address if it is to continue to prosper and succeed.
- The Plan must be created/updated at least every six years.

## **Pathways to Opportunity Plan - Goals**


Remove barriers to access and attainment, especially for Black, Hispanic, Native American and rural students; students learning English as a second language; students from economically disadvantaged backgrounds; and students with disabilities.



Invest in and support the development of initiatives that provide cost savings to students while maintaining the effectiveness of instruction.

Increase the social, cultural and economic well-being of individuals and communities within the Commonwealth and its regions.

  - Emphasize topics of concern to Council.
- Approved the current biennial (2023-2025) slate of priority initiatives on October 24, 2023.
- Receive regular updates from staff on specific/all initiatives.

#### **Goal 1 – Close Access and Completion Gaps**

Plan Biennial Initiative I.1 Promote access to postsecondary education	<u>Updated Actions to implement initiative</u> Level Up Virginia website and social media campaign launched; Led financial aid and FAFSA outreach/assistance efforts and access programming for GEAR UP cohort. (May)
I.2 Support Online Virginia Network (OVN) market survey	Survey developed by VCU Survey and Evaluation Research Laboratory and completed by 243 former VA college students that have not completed a degree.
I.3 Develop resources for mental health and disabilities supports	Mental Health Pilot Round one pilot continues to increase counseling capacity, reduce staff burnout. Round two pilot grants awarded.
	Virginia Mental Health Access Program (VMAP) collaboration yielded two webinars for CME credit; more than 60 on-campus medical health professionals participated in each webinar.
	Best practice guidelines document and SB 21 report produced by advisory committee/work group to support students with disabilities. (July)

I.8 Scale Virginia Talent + Opportunity Partnership (V- TOP).	Statewide staffing agency engaged 149 small/mid-sized employers and placed 83 students in internships. Completed academic data governance work group activities. (January and May)
I.9 Establish criteria for high demand jobs.	Collaborating with Virginia Office of Education Economics (VOEE) on "Degree Program Alignment Report" to be released in spring 2025. Approved 12 new education licensure degree programs for four institutions. Second round of approvals will culminate at the March 2025 Council meeting. (January)
I.10 Foster activities/partnerships that improve students' civic	Fourteen institutions have signed on as members of the SCHEV-Constructive Dialogue Institute cohort.
knowledge and ability to contribute effectively to civic life.	Staff led a faculty learning community in Spring 2024 on "Integrating Dialogue Skills into Classroom Teaching."
